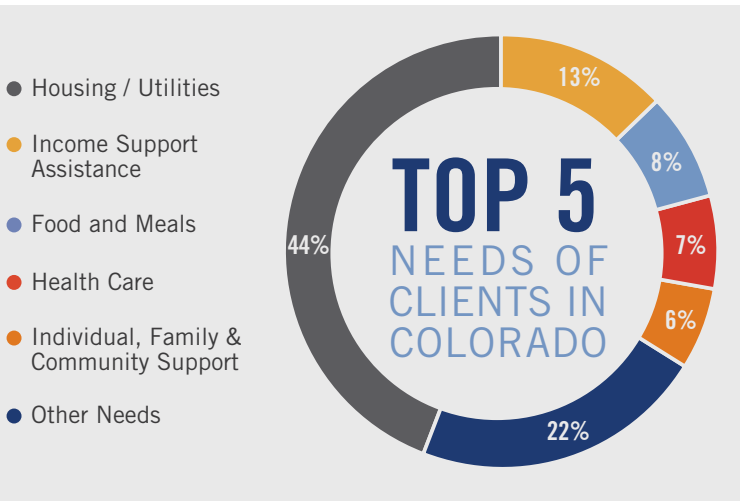
THE NUMBER OF CONTACTS

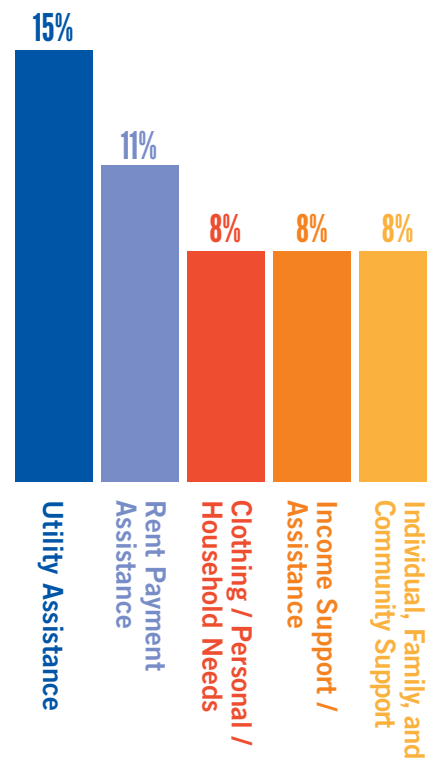
